Everyone's welcome to come along to this popular event, either with or without fruit. A press takes about six buckets of dessert or cooking apples; juice from cooking apples might be zingy and benefit from adding lemonade when serving! Bring six buckets, or whatever you have to add to apples from others for a community press. Bring clean plastic bottles – cordial or lemonade bottles are perfect. Milk bottles are ok, but be sure to wash well or sterilise. We usually run out of bottles, not apples. There will be juice to taste. We don't bring a pasteuriser for the juice but it does freeze well. Equipment is hired from South Lakeland Orchard Group (SLOG) by the Parish News.
