South Lakes

**We are finding it hard to manage financially because our wages have not gone up in line with all the bills. We don't spend money on luxuries. What can we do?**

If you need financial help, you should always start by checking if you can get any benefits. You can [use the calculator on the Turn2us website](#).

This will give you a quick idea of what you might be able to claim.

Don't be put off applying, possibly because you feel embarrassed. Benefits are there to support you when you're struggling, or just need that bit of extra income to manage. They aren't only for people who are unemployed.

Benefits calculators can't give you a definite answer or amount, but it's still worth checking. To get the most accurate answer possible, you'll need information about your savings, income, and any other money coming in.

If you are eligible, it's always worth claiming, even if the actual amount you can get is small. It can entitle you to other financial support, for example help with rent and Council Tax, energy costs, and other bills.

If you have trouble making an application, contact South Lakes Citizens Advice for help. We know dealing with the benefits system can be intimidating, especially if you haven't made a claim before. There are parts of the system that can take time and be hard to navigate. But it's usually worth it - and you don't have to do it alone. And if you can't get benefits, your adviser will know if there is other financial help available.

If you are having problems with the supplier, or they ask your mother to pay for the change, contact South Lakes Citizens Advice for help.

Dear Friends,

Not many 1,700-year-old documents are read out loud every week and known by heart by millions of people worldwide. One such document is the Nicene Creed. What is that, and what is for?



The Church in its earliest centuries <sup>faced</sup> persecution, but by the fourth century, the Emperor Constantine had declared his faith as a Christian. Official persecution had stopped and so the Church had space to reflect on what it read in the Bible. One truth it needed to express truly and thoroughly was about the person of Christ: how could Jesus be perfectly God and perfectly man in one person?

One man, Arius, had proposed his theory: Jesus was a very holy and a God-like man, close to God but not actually God. The Church finally and correctly saw this as dangerous heresy: after all, only God can truly make God known to us, only God can rescue, and only God is to be worshipped. If Jesus is not God, the whole Christian church is guilty of idolatry, for they would be worshipping a created being and not the Creator.

However, 1700 years ago, the stakes were high. The entire shape of the Christian message would be affected, as well as the future direction of the Church. In AD 325, representatives of the Christian church gathered at Nicaea, in modern Turkey to tackle the controversy; even St Nicholas (yes, that one!) was there, as Bishop of Myra.

After agony and much debate, a statement was produced. This became the basis of what is now called the Nicene Creed. It is believed by millions of Christians and mainstream churches around the world. Some say it in their services as a collective declaration of faith. Its printed words on the page give little indication that these truths were hard won.

So what? Is this the Church simply collecting old and arcane things? Is this the Church arguing over obscure matters, like the number of angels on a pinhead? How is it relevant today?

It is relevant because the God it describes is the same God today; he is always our contemporary. It outlines the pattern of God's love in Jesus, the love that is still there for this generation.

Specifically, it reminds us of the most important truths: who God is, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and who Jesus is, as both God and human. God is always bigger and greater than our minds and imagination, yet in Jesus he came to our level, living an authentic human life and speaking truth in human words. While the Creed is not found in the Bible, it is a concise summary of what the Bible teaches about God, Christ, and the Holy Spirit. The truths contained in the Nicene Creed are not merely abstract concepts but are vital to understanding how God loves and rescues us.
