Heversham Parish Council have been informed by Dallam that there is extensive Ash Die Back on the old railway line alongside Tristrams Playing Field and felling will be required. This means that there will be periods when sections of the permissive footpath from Wilson's field to Tristrams have to be closed for safety reasons. The work is expected to begin in November. The contractors will be working in phases, so any closure is not expected to be for long periods. When the section from the Woodhouse Lane Bridge to the stile into Tristrams has to be closed, Dallam will grant temporary access along the field side of the trees - but ask walkers to keep to the edge of the playing field keeping dogs under control.

I'm really worried that I won't be able to afford to keep warm this winter. I don't want to claim benefits, and I don't think I would get anything anyway because I get a State Pension.

If you have reached pension age, and your income is below a minimum amount decided by the government, you are entitled to Pension Credit, and there is nothing to be embarrassed about in claiming what you qualify for. It's worth applying even if you don't think you'll get much, because if you receive Pension Credit, even a small amount, you'll be able to get the Winter Fuel Payment, and other financial help.

There are two parts to Pension Credit. Guarantee Credit tops up your weekly income to a minimum amount. Savings Credit is a small top-up for people who have a modest amount of income or savings. It's only available if you reached State Pension age before 6 April 2016. You might get one or both parts, depending on your circumstances.

13th October 9.30 am at St Peter's Church Heversham Developments at St Peter's Church It is great to be able to give two exciting updates about developments at St Peter's, the first of which is the Ashes Area

Ashes Area

Phase 1 of improvements to the Ashes Area, the lawn and surroundings where ashes are interred, was completed in August. Feedback has been very positive that the Ashes Area can now be readily identified through the new paths and boundary stones, several people have commented that the special nature of that part of the churchyard is now very clear.

The letters and numbers on the engraved kerb stones make it easy to envisage the grid in which different ashes have been interred.

We are now ready to move into Phase 2 of the improvements, which will really make sense of what can be seen on the ground, as an annotated plan of the grid will show whose ashes are where.

To the west side of the grassed area, paving has been laid and a stand, a lectern, will be placed there to hold a large slate memorial to overlook the interment area. The slate memorial will be engraved with a grid that matches that envisaged by the letters and numbers on the kerbs. Within the grid will be the names and date of death of the people whose ashes lie there.

Phase 1 of the improvements has been funded by generous contributions from people with an interest in the improvement and by the PCC, though the PCC has very limited funds for such a project.

As we move into Phase 2, the balance remaining to complete the project is approaching £10,000, which seems to be an inordinate amount of money. It is explained through the need to cover the residue of costs from Phase 1, largely part of the final paving, and through the cost of the slate memorial. The slate memorial will be engraved with the records of in excess of 100 earlier interments and that is an expensive business. Early in the project it was obvious that all interments, including historic ones, must be included on the slate memorial and that the improvements to the area are for everyone, not just those yet to come. It is important that the memorial is a complete memorial for all whose ashes are interred there. At such a location in the churchyard, and with the significance of the lectern itself, it is important that it is of a design and quality that reflects its purpose. That is not a cheap matter either and it is also reflected in the remaining costs to complete the project.

Phase 2 of the improvements, completion of the project, will not take place until the PCC has sufficient funds to meet the cost.

Developments at St Peter's Church

The second exciting development at St Peter's is the improvement and modernisation of the entrance area. We expect this work to be underway

this winter. Anybody using the church will know that the entrance area is not very user-friendly. Not only is the Victorian draught lobby small, dark and awkward but it is ineffective at eliminating draughts when the church is in use. A step at the church entrance presents a difficulty for some people and can be a trip hazard for many.

Church users who have any mobility difficulties find the entrance a challenge to use and wheelchair users find it exceptionally difficult even with the removable ramp in place.

Once in church the toilet facilities are cramped, primitive and not suitable for everybody.

The entrance improvements will overcome these difficulties through forming a ramp at the entrance to eliminate the step, creating a modern, glazed, draught excluder lobby and providing modern toilet facilities suitable for all.

Additional bonuses of the work are that more space will be created just inside church and there will be a much better area to welcome people in. The carved Victorian draught screen will fit nicely across the end wall of the south aisle and form a division between the church and the toilet area.

Dear Friends,



Harvest thanksgiving might raise quaint and homely images of church life, buildings decorated with produce as a choir sings "Come ye thankful people come.". What place does a harvest season have when so much produce is available in shops the whole year round?

On the other hand, is there not a case for gratitude? It reminds us that we are dependent on a number of factors for our daily living - on the environment and what goes into the food chain. In the last couple of years we have seen how war has affected the price and supplies of wheat, a staple of human sustenance. What if we used autumn and its associations with harvest to make time for gratitude?

How would we answer the questions, "Am I thankful?" and "What am I thankful for?" We might express gratitude for family, for health, for food, for work, for time to enjoy life together.

But when we're thankful for family—whom are we thanking? Family members? Perhaps. What about expressing thankfulness for health? Are you thanking medical professionals, the NHS? Maybe. When we're thankful for life and wellbeing in general, to whom are we directing our gratitude? Ourselves? Or even God?

The prophet Isaiah reminded his generation that God is the Creator of all things: Have you not known? Have you not heard? The LORD is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth. He does not faint or grow weary; his understanding is unsearchable. (Isaiah 40:28)

He made families; they're his idea. And he placed you in your family. The Bible describes the Father as the one "from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name." Ephesians 3.15

God created all things, including tastebuds as well as food, to be relished and enjoyed. He created fruit, vegetables, and meats, and he gave humans the skills to cultivate these and prepare them in delicious meals.

Thanksgiving means looking at things given like one would look at a window. We can look at it, and see merely the glass and the frame, the immediate object. Or, better still, we can look through it and see the wider view beyond. That's truly what a window is for.

God made everything to point to him, to direct our eyes beyond the immediate and obvious.

Saint Paul told the philosophers in Athens that this is why God gives humanity good things and the basic needs for life. "God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him." (Acts 17.27)

What if we developed an attitude not just of thankfulness for gifts, but of thanksgiving to the Giver? That we might begin to see through all the gifts we enjoy, and see all the way to the Giver. And give him thanks.
